3. A solid working knowledge of Early Years Learning Frameworks
4. Strong communication and ICT skills
5. A willingness to work as a team
6. A diligent worker with good organizational ability
7. Awareness of current Child Protection provisions and a demonstrated ability to work safely with children

Minimum requirements for this position include:

- Approved ACECQA Degree-level qualification in Early Childhood Education and Care
- Current Working With Children Check
- Police Check
- Child Protection Training
- First Aid Training (including Anaphylaxis and Asthma)
