# Frequently Asked Questions about English and Literature

Do all year 11 students have to do either English or Literature? - Yes

Can a year 11 student do both English and Literature? - Yes

Can a year 11 student do just English or Literature? - Yes

**Are there any prerequisites to Literature? - No -** although it is advisable that you are currently getting reasonable marks in English

### Who should do Literature? -

students interested in reading students interested in creative writing students interested in close reading of texts students interested in a range of texts students who like a smaller class Students who like exploring ideas

## Does it help if I like reading to do Lit? - Yes

- but it is a good subject for people interested in other creative arts like film, graphic novels, anime, music, drama, musicals

# Important information -

All students in the VCE pathway have to do at least either English <u>and/or</u> Literature in Year's 11 and 12

Students doing VCE have to include their score for English or Literature in their top 4 ATAR scores

We encourage students interested in doing Literature to try it in Year 11

We encourage students trying Literature in Year 11 to do Year 11 English as well at least in Year 11

Yet, students do not have to do both English and Literature at Year 11

Students can change back from Literature in Year 11 to English in Year 12

Students can change from English to Literature in Year 12 but this is more difficult
