



Expression of Interest – Central Australia Trip 2026

We are delighted to be proposing another College Trip to Central Australia in **March 2026** as part of our Secondary camps week program and are looking to gauge interest from 2025 Year 9 families.

The Central Australia Trip is a cultural tour that involves visiting Coober Pedy, Alice Springs, MacDonnell Ranges, Kata Tjuta, Watarrka and Uluru.



Year 10 Camp: Central Australia 2026

Date: Monday 23 March – Thursday 2 April 2026 (11 days). Last two school weeks of Term One.


Transport: Coach to Central Australia & Flight from Uluru to Melbourne

Accommodation: Camping in canvas tents and bunkrooms.

Inclusions: Transport, accommodation, meals (breakfasts, morning tea, lunches and dinners) and all activities.

Cost: \$ 1,750 (cost includes a College subsidy applied)

To secure a position, a non-refundable deposit of \$250 for each student is required by **Thursday 21 August (three weeks)**.




Itinerary


DAY 4: Drive to Alice Springs

DAY 7: Alice Springs - Watarrka National Park, Karrke Aboriginal Cultural Experience




Lilla Aboriginal Community.


DAY 9: Watarrka → Uluru -Uluru-Kata Tjuta
