Building Fund: \$500 per family per year. The College operates a compulsory Building Fund levy (non-tax deductible).

Regular Payment Options (no discount)

- Monthly (10 instalments) Payable by 6th of each month starting 6 December 2019
- Fortnightly (22 instalments) Payable Fridays fortnightly from 6 December 2019 to 25 September 2020
- Weekly (43 instalments) Payable every Friday from 6 December to 25 September 2020

Fees are to be finalised by 30th September 2020 and can be made using the following methods:

- Direct debit by the College | Internet (BPay, bank transfer) | In person (credit card)
- Cash / cheque payments paid directly into our ANZ Bank Account at an ANZ Branch (not to the College)

Additional VET and OES / Biology Camp Costs

- VET Fees for VCAL students are in addition to College fees and are set by the Training Organisation.
- VET Hospitality or Agriculture undertaken at the College has a fee of \$500.
- Years 9/10 OES Camp \$250 | VCE Year 11 Biology Camp \$300 | VCE OES Camp \$400

Bus Passes: \$860 per student per year plus any State Government Bus Travel Conveyance Allowance.

Individual casual use tickets can be purchased for \$5.00 one way or \$10.00 round trip.

Health-Care Card and Pension Card discounts: The CSEF (Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund) is a Victorian government allowance to assist families with a current means-tested Pension Card or Health Care Card (HCC) with \$125 per Primary student or \$225 per Secondary student as a fee discount. Eligible families apply through the College Finance Office.

Do you drive more than 4.8km to the college? A Conveyance Allowance may be available

Families who drive more than 4.8 kilometres to the College (by the shortest practical route) may be eligible for a conveyance allowance. Please see the Finance Office to complete a conveyance allowance form.

Withdrawal from the College: A minimum of **one full term's notice** in writing is required. A full term's fees will be charged when less than one full term's notice is provided.
