Fee Inclusions



Annual Tuition Fees

Tuition fees are billed annually with options to pay in instalments. These fees are inclusive of the core cost of tuition, stationery, excursions and camps for your child, and many materials, texts and other costs.

The Years 7-9 tuition fee includes a rental fee for the take-home Chromebook. A \$500 'Lease to Own' fee is included for the Years 10-12 MacBook. Some other charges may apply to optional activities and specific classes of choice such as VCE classes, and some supplementary resources.



VCAL & VET Subsidies

VCAL tuition fees are lower than VCE fees to reflect the additional fees required for VET courses.

VET courses receive only limited government support toward the external cost of provision. Any relevant funding received is used to reduce per student costs, but additional course or materials costs set by the RTO Provider have to be met by parents. These VET fees are added to family fee accounts. Parents should seek confirmation of fees from the VET Coordinator prior to enrolment.

VCE students who also enrol in an external VET course will receive a \$1,500 subsidy upon successful completion of their course.



Camps & Outdoor Education

Year level camps and excursions are included in College tuition fees. Extra charges may apply for non-compulsory excursions or camps, or for those related to specific elective classes of choice.

Celebrating 40 Years

The year 2022 provides us with an opportunity to celebrate our 40th anniversary, revisit our historical beginnings, and also create a vision for 2030 and beyond.

Our College has grown from a small school started in 1982 by committed parents who mortgaged their homes, to a College that runs from 3 year old ELC to VCAL and VCE.

To meet our operating expenses we have our annual tuition fees, but to continue to grow and fulfil our vision we need your ongoing commitment, support and involvement. For all your contributions in the past we are extremely thankful.



Bayside Building Fund

While we no longer include a compulsory Building Fund Levy in our College fees, the College encourages families who have been less affected by COVID-19 disruptions to consider making a voluntary, tax-deductible Building Fund donation.

The College has extended the Term 1 payment deadline to 10 January, 2022 to assist the community. All fees are to be finalised by 16 September, 2022.

Additional Fees

- \$250 Years 9/10 OES Camp
- \$300 VCE Year 11 Biology Camp
- \$400 VCE OES Camp
- \$500 VET Hospitality or Agriculture undertaken at the College
- VET Fees for VCAL students are set by the Training Organisation

Payment options

A variety of payment frequencies are available including yearly, half-yearly, quarterly, monthly and fortnightly. Payment options include:

- Direct debit by the College
- Internet (BPay, bank transfer)
- In person (credit card)
- Cash / cheque payments paid directly into our ANZ Bank Account at an ANZ Branch.

Sibling Discounts

Sibling discounts are applied to the second and third child in the family. Fourth and subsequent children are not charged College tuition fees.

Government Discounts

The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund is a Victorian Government allowance to assist families with a current means-tested Pension Card or Health Care Card with \$125 per Primary student or \$225 per Secondary student applied as a fee discount. Eligible families can apply through the Finance Office.

Conveyance (Travel) Allowance

Families who drive more than 4.8 kilometres to the College (by the shortest practical route) may be eligible for a conveyance allowance. See the Finance Office to complete a Conveyance Allowance form.

College Bus Passes

\$860 per student per year less any Conveyance Allowance. Casual use tickets can be purchased for \$5 one-way or \$10 per round trip.

Withdrawal from the College

A minimum of one full term's notice in writing is required. A full term's fees are charged when less than one full term's notice is provided.
